A Historical Site, Through and Through

Tucked away in the heart of Tsim Sha Tsui, FWD HOUSE 1881 — formerly known as the Marine Police Headquarters — was declared a monument in 1994. Its Victorian neoclassical architecture boasts an elegant aura and brims with historical significance.



A three-pounder Hotchkiss gun once stood on the lawn's northwest corner. It was exchanged with Jardine's Noonday Gun in 1961, and the original moved to Sai Wan Ho in 1996. The current display is a replica from overseas.



The Main Building of the Former Marine Police Headquarters was fitted with fireplaces. The original, intricately-designed cast-iron fireplaces have been preserved.



Three holding cells with over a hundred year of history housed at the Former Marine Police Headquarters have been preserved.


